SUNDAY WORKING BRANCH 2ND AND 4TH SATURDAY HOLIDAY

Further to our letter No. 6466/47/15 dated 02.09.2015 dated, we wish to bring to your kind notice the issue of branches having “off days” other than Sundays. Many branches in different circles have Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, as holiday. The preceding day was a half day.

2. But now on account of implementation of the 2nd & 4th Saturday's off, many circles have declared the 2nd and 4th Saturday as holiday and converted the preceding half day into a full day working. Consequently such branches now have disjointed holiday as the case may be. This has created disjointed holidays and the concerned officers are not able to enjoy the fruits of continuous of 2 days holidays/weekend. We therefore request you to look into this situation and ensure that all Sunday working branches are converted to Sunday holiday ranches. Till such time this is done the preceding 2nd and 4th half days may be declared as holidays.

3. We are herewith enclosing an example and the list of branch holidays on various days in Lucknow Circle. Similar is the situation in many circles also. As there is lot of confusion and different circles are interpreting differently, an early solution and suitable instructions to all the circles will be appreciated to enable the officers to enjoy the fruits of a 2nd day weekend.
