## (ANIRUDH AKHAURI) GENERAL SECRETARY <u>RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE SCHEME</u> EXTENSION OF COVERAGE AND ENHANCEMENT OF CEILINGS

Please refer our Circular No. 14 dated 19.02.2010. As a result of our representation and further follow up, we are glad to advise that Management has allowed to MMGS – II and above, the facility of official telephone at their residence. The existing ceilings of monthly telephone calls on official telephones provided to officers at their residence have been revised with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2010 as under:

OFFICERS	REVISED LIMIT ON NO. OF CALLS PER MONTH
JMGS – I	300
MMGS – II & III	450
SMGS –IV & V	1200
TEGS – VI	2100
TEGS – VII	2800
TEGSS – I	4200
TEGSS – II	5600

i) The officers will now be allowed to carryover of unused calls in a particular month up to the end of each calendar quarter.

- ii) Presently there are many service providers of base telephones and there is no similarity in rates and services offered by them. To bring uniformity in call charges, when service providers are different, it has been decided that for reimbursement purpose to Officers, MTNL/BSNL rates may be treated as base rates.
- iii) Now a days, besides telephone, internet channel has been the most used channel for communication by the Officers to communicate with the customers and also for official purposes. At present, we do not have provision for payment of internet charges. To regularise this, it has been decided that within the total entitlement of telephone reimbursement (plus rental and taxes) the internet/broadband charges may be included.

2. The Official Circular has already been issued. Members may please take note of the improvements.
